

## Scholarship Models

The Master in Research and Innovation in Higher Education (MARIHE) is an Erasmus Mundus Masters Course supported by the Erasmus Mundus Programme of the European Commission. High potential candidates from all over the world can apply for an Erasmus Mundus Scholarship, which is offered in two categories. Following these two categories, two scholarship models for further scholarship offers can be defined:

### Scholarships for students that will not be able to self-fund their participation or to find additional sources of funding:

For these students we suggest the scholarship to include:

- **Participation costs** (tuition fees) of 12 000 EUR for the four semester programme
- **Subsistence costs** of 24 000 EUR (paid in 24 monthly allowances of 1 000 EUR each)
- **Contribution to travel**, installation and any other type of costs of 7 000 EUR

The total amount of this scholarship is 43 000 EUR.

### Scholarships for students that may be able to partly fund the expenses of their participation through private and other sources:

For these students we suggest the scholarship to include:

- **Participation costs** (tuition fees) of 12 000 EUR for the four semester programme
- **Subsistence costs** of 12 000 EUR (paid in 24 monthly allowances of 500 EUR each)
- **Contribution to travel**, installation and any other type of costs of 4 000 EUR

The total amount of this scholarship is 32 000 EUR.

In both cases the participation costs include a **student health and accident insurance** with worldwide coverage for the whole duration of the programme. This insurance is handled by the MARIHE consortium.

If the funding institution wishes, the payments to the individual scholarship holders can be managed by the MARIHE Consortium.
