

Call for Applications - Erasmus+ Staff Training & Teaching winter term 2024/25

for Staff of University of Pristina, Kosovo

Hochschule für nachhaltige Entwicklung Eberswalde (HNEE / Eberswalde University for Sustainable Development) **calls for applications** to participate in the Erasmus + **staff-training programme**. Academic and administrative staff can apply for a training on different topics and/or of different teaching methods and tools through lesson/module attendance at HNEE. Academic staff may also apply for a guest teaching mobility at HNEE. The applicants select module(s) offered by HNEE based on their own academic research, teaching experiences and interests. **Please find attached an overview of block modules offered at our university.**

CONDITIONS

Please state 2 block modules of interest in your application. We will check the availability of the courses and let you know which one you can attend. The Erasmus+ funding grant includes a daily sum-lump to cover the living expenses (160,00€/per day for 14 days) incurred in Germany (accommodation and meals) for the duration of the mobility as well as a one-time travel allowance (275,00€, Top up for Green Travel (bus or train) 320,00€).

If you would like to participate in the Erasmus+ programme, you need to apply the International Office at your home university until **October 6th 2024 (Attention! some modules are starting in September already, please apply asap if you are interested in those!)** via email: blerande.dragusha@uni-pr.edu.
