### CONDITIONS:

If you are selected to participate in the Erasmus+ program as an exchange student, you will receive a grant that assures the payment of the living costs in Germany (850,00€ - 1.100,00€ / month). Each selected participant will also get a travel contribution of 275,00€. The winter term 2025/26 starts on the **September 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2025 and ends on February 20<sup>th</sup>, 2026**. It is expected of all students to arrive at least a week before the start of the term.

### APPLICATION:

If you wish to participate in the Erasmus+ exchange, first you need to apply directly at the International Relations Office at University of Pristina. In case you are selected and pre-nominated by your home university, you will receive further information about the application process from HNEE. Make sure you apply with the following documents:

- **Motivational letter** for the chosen study programme
- **Current enrolment certificate** from your home university with a current date!
- **Transcript of records**
- **Language certificate** must comply with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR)

*An application only has a chance to be successful if all documents are submitted together and completed in full.. Otherwise, your application cannot be taken into consideration.*
