CONDITIONS:

If you are selected to participate in the Erasmus+ programme as an exchange student, you will receive a grant that assures the payment of the living costs in Germany (850€/ month). Each selected participant will also get a travel contribution of 275 €.

Summer term 2023 starts on the **20**th of March 2023 and ends on the **4**th of August 2023. It is expected of all students to arrive at least a week before the start of the term.

APPLICATION:

If you want to participate, you need to apply via HNEE online application portal: www.hnee.de/exchangepartner

The online application portal is open between **18**th **August 2022 and 23**rd **October 2022**. Afterwards the portal will be closed and new applications can then no longer be submitted.

An application only has a chance of being successful if the documents have been **submitted in complete form** (including the language certificates). All certificates must comply with the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR). Otherwise your application cannot be taken into consideration.
