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INTRODUCTION

Founded on 18 November 1969, the University of Prishtina formally held its Founding Assembly on 15 February 1970, a date that has since been celebrated as University of Prishtina Day. University of Prishtina is Kosovo's oldest, largest, and most prominent public university. It consistently holds the leading position among Albanian-language universities across the Western Balkans on major international ranking platforms.

More than any other institution in the country, the University of Prishtina has been central to Kosovo's economic, social, and cultural development. Today, it educates around 24,000 students at bachelor's, master's, and doctoral levels through 14 academic units. Its academic mission is delivered by over 900 professors and experts, supported by a professional administrative staff of more than 250.

The University's international profile has strengthened markedly in recent years. In October 2025 Times Higher Education (THE) rankings achieved its most significant year-on-year progress, recording a 25.23% increase in the International Outlook indicator. Further improvements were noted in Research Environment (7.69%), Teaching (6.3%), and Industry Engagement (1.99%). In July 2025 Webometrics ranking, the University of Prishtina was placed among the top 2,500 universities worldwide, out of more than 33,000 institutions assessed.

Internationalization has long been a strategic priority of the University of Prishtina. Through sustained academic networking and cooperation with partner institutions across all continents, the University continues to expand its global engagement in education, research, and innovation.



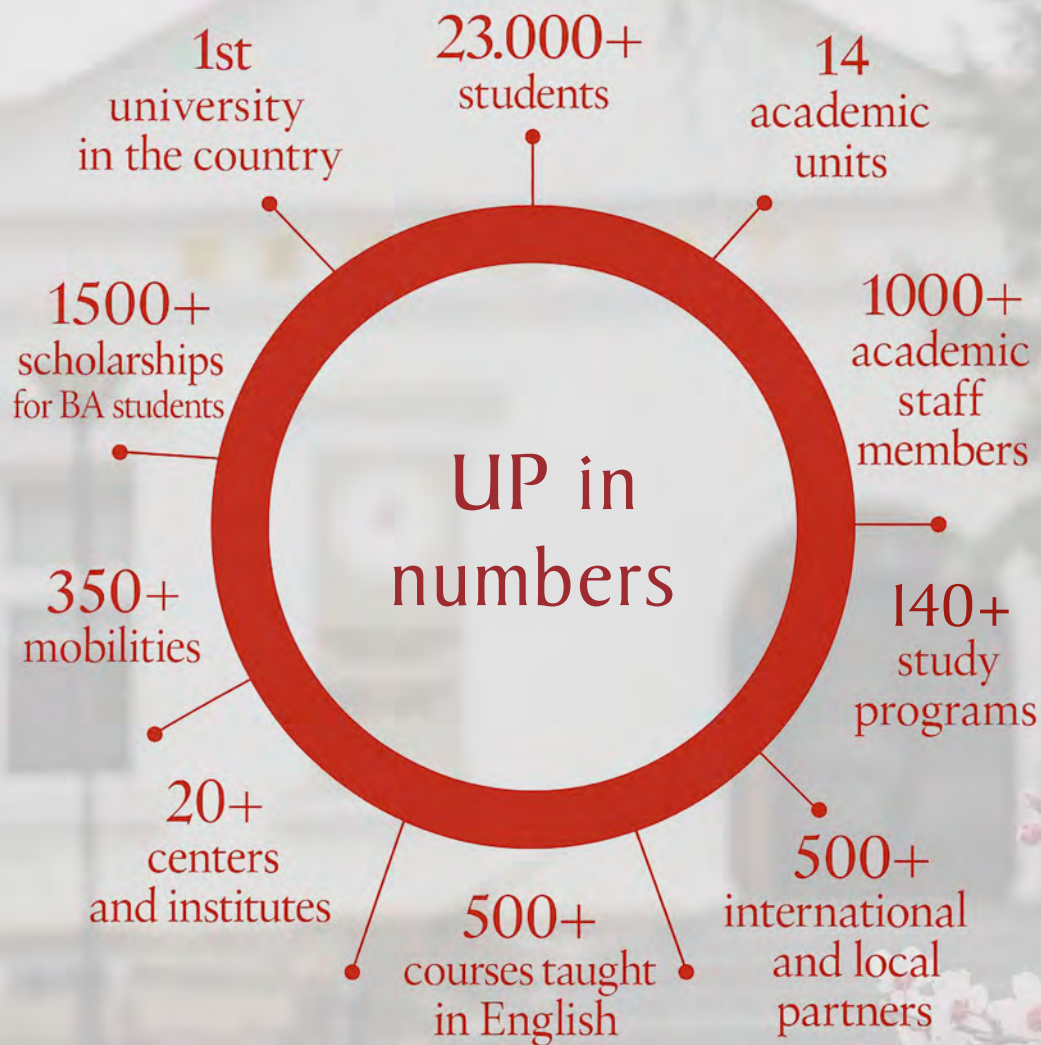

The University of Prishtina organizes studies in accordance with existing study programs during the academic year, which lasts 12 months. The academic year begins on the 15th of September and ends on the 14th of September. The active period of studies (lectures, exercises, seminars, midterm tests, practical work, etc.) is divided into two semesters.

WARM UP - WINTER ACADEMY AT UP



The Winter School “WARM UP – Winter Academy of Research Methods” at the University of Prishtina is an academic platform dedicated to advancing doctoral studies and scientific research, serving as a space for knowledge exchange between experienced researchers and early-career scholars. It focuses on contemporary practices in the development of doctoral programmes, the challenges of research, and its alignment with societal needs, public policies, and industry. The first edition of WARM UP was held from 25 to 27 February 2026, with the support of the Luxembourg Development Cooperation Agency (LuxDev) and the Embassy of the Grand Duchy of Luxembourg in Kosovo.

STUDY PROGRAMS AND COURSES TAUGHT IN ENGLISH AND IN OTHER FOREIGN LANGUAGES

UP OFFERS MORE THAN 500 COURSES AND SEMINARS IN ENGLISH, GERMAN, ITALIAN AND OTHER FOREIGN LANGUAGES, AND SOME STUDY PROGRAMS ENTIRELY IN ENGLISH.



University of Prishtina consists of 14 faculties. Depending on your field of study, you will be officially enrolled at one of these faculties during your stay. That will be your host faculty. Every faculty offers a variety of courses and seminars in English, German, Italian and other foreign languages. Most of the faculties present the lists of courses on their websites.

University of Prishtina currently offers following study programs in English language:

1. Applied Economics and Management (BA)
2. Human Rights, International Criminal Law and Transitional Justice (MA)
3. Integrated Water Resources Management (MA).

THE INTERNATIONAL SEMINAR ON ALBANIAN LANGUAGE, LITERATURE AND CULTURE

The International Seminar on Albanian Language, Literature, and Culture, initially established as the Seminar on Albanian Culture for Foreign Participants, is widely regarded as the most significant academic event worldwide in the field of Albanian studies. Founded in 1974 at the Faculty of Philology (then the Faculty of Philosophy) of the University of Prishtina, the Seminar has been held annually in Prishtina and has since served as a central forum for scholarly exchange in Albanology, bringing together researchers, academics, and students from Kosovo, Albania, the region, and the international academic community to engage in advanced discussions on Albanian language, literature, and culture.

The Seminar has so far organized 42 Sessions. In 1991 the imposed Serbian rule discontinued the activities of the Seminar. In 1995 and 1996, in co-operation with the Institute of Linguistics and Literature of the Academy of Sciences and Arts of Albania, the Seminar was forced to develop its activities in Tirana. Since the year 2000 the Seminar performs its activities in Prishtina. The 19th and the 20th sessions were organized in cooperation with the Institute of Linguistics and Literature of the Academy of Sciences of Albania. In 2020, its activities were discontinued due to Covid 19 pandemic.



FROM DIASPORA TO IMPACT:

To become a university that effectively navigates rapid technological change and harnesses artificial intelligence, the University of Prishtina, on the initiative of Rector Prof. Dr. Arben Hajrullahu, launched the "Brain Circulation" project. This initiative invites professionals, primarily from the Kosovar academic diaspora working at 400 of the world's top universities (according to the Times Higher Education and QS World University Rankings), to build formal ties with the University.

This led to the drafting and subsequent approval by the University Senate, on 30 April 2025, of the Regulation on Transfer, the 'Brain Gain' Programme, and Cases of Exceptional Need for Academic Staff Recruitment.

Under this regulation, until mid 2026, the University of Prishtina has affiliated and recruited 9 professors. Further affiliations with new and promising professionals are expected in the coming year.



Gëzim Visoka, a former student of the University of Prishtina, currently works at Dublin City University and is also a research collaborator at the University of Oxford.

Dukagjin Blakaj is a physician of international renown and a professor at The Ohio State University, where he also heads the Department of Head and Neck Radiation Oncology.



Driton Vllasaliu is a pharmacist-physician and professor at King's College London.

Besnik Pula is an Associate Professor of Political Science and Director of the International Studies Program in the Department of Political Science at Virginia Tech.



A STRATEGIC BRAIN GAIN INITIATIVE



Zanfina Ademi is the world's most cited Albanian women's scholar. The professor, who has published more than 200 papers in leading international health journals, leads the Health Economics and Policy Evaluation Research (HEPER) Group in Monash University's Faculty of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Sciences.

Miranda Kajtazi has been an Associate Professor in the Department of Informatics at Lund University since 2015. Since 2019 alone, Professor Kajtazi has published 35 scientific papers in top international journals in her areas of expertise.



Isa Blumi is a Professor of World History and Middle Eastern Studies within Stockholm University's Department of Asian and Middle Eastern Studies. His academic credentials include a PhD in History and Middle Eastern/Islamic Studies from New York University and a Master's degree in Political Science and Historical Studies from The New School for Social Research in New York.

Venet Osmani At Queen Mary University, teaches Clinical AI and Machine Learning and leads a technology laboratory called the "Osmani Lab" within the Digital Environment Research Institute (DERI), in Queen Mary University, London.



Ilir Murturi, from the Vienna University of Technology has been recruited as an assistant professor at University of Prishtina through the Brain Gain programme.

FORUM OF ACADEMIC DIASPORA AT THE UNIVERSITY OF PRISHTINA

The University of Prishtina, through the Center for Advanced Studies (CAS), organizes the Academic Diaspora Forum as part of a consolidated platform for cooperation with the academic diaspora. This platform provides a structured space for connecting academics in Kosova with those in the diaspora, offering opportunities for joint research, fellowship programs, scientific activities, and professional networking. The Forum brings together diaspora scholars, UP staff and students, as well as institutional representatives and supporting organizations, strengthening the institutionalization of this cooperation and directing knowledge toward societal development. Within this framework, the University of Prishtina further deepens its sustainable engagement with the diaspora through mechanisms such as the “Brain Gain” program and policies for brain circulation, consolidating its role as an active hub of international academic collaboration. With the support of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Diaspora and GIZ Kosova, the first edition of this forum, “Bashkë në Shkencë: Universiteti i Prishtinës dhe Diaspora Akademike”, was held in October 2025, bringing together over 20 members of Kosova’s academic diaspora from across the globe.



CAREER DEVELOPMENT CENTER

The Career Development Center (CDC) of the University of Prishtina represents a bridge between the university, students, graduates and the labor market. With the mission to empower students to consciously and effectively guide their professional journey, the CDC offers individual career counseling, training and workshops for the development of professional skills, opportunities for practical work, internships and volunteering, as well as networking activities with employers, institutions and partner organizations. Through digital platforms such as “e-Carrier” and the “SEMS Internship” module, the Center facilitates the connection of students and graduates with the public and private sectors, creating concrete opportunities for professional development and integration into the labor market.

In addition to direct support for students, the CDC also contributes to research, alumni tracking, the publication of the “Career” magazine and the promotion of sustainable cooperation between the University of Prishtina and the employer community. With a commitment to quality, inclusiveness, diversity, and continuous development, the Center remains a valuable resource for preparing students for a successful, sustainable and competitive future at the local, national and international levels.



CENTER OF EXCELLENCE IN TEACHING

The Center for Excellence in Teaching (CET) of the University of Prishtina contributes to the advancement of the quality of teaching and learning through training, workshops, conferences and the development of didactic resources. In addition to its role within the University of Prishtina, the CET serves as a national center for capacity building in higher education, offering professional programs and collaboration opportunities for academic staff from other higher education institutions in Kosovo.

Through academic networking, exchange of good practices and collaboration with local and international experts, the center promotes pedagogical innovation, the digital transformation of education and the integration of artificial intelligence in teaching and learning processes. In this way, CET contributes to strengthening academic staff, improving student experience and raising the quality of higher education in Kosovo, by promoting a culture of continuous improvement, inclusiveness and academic excellence.

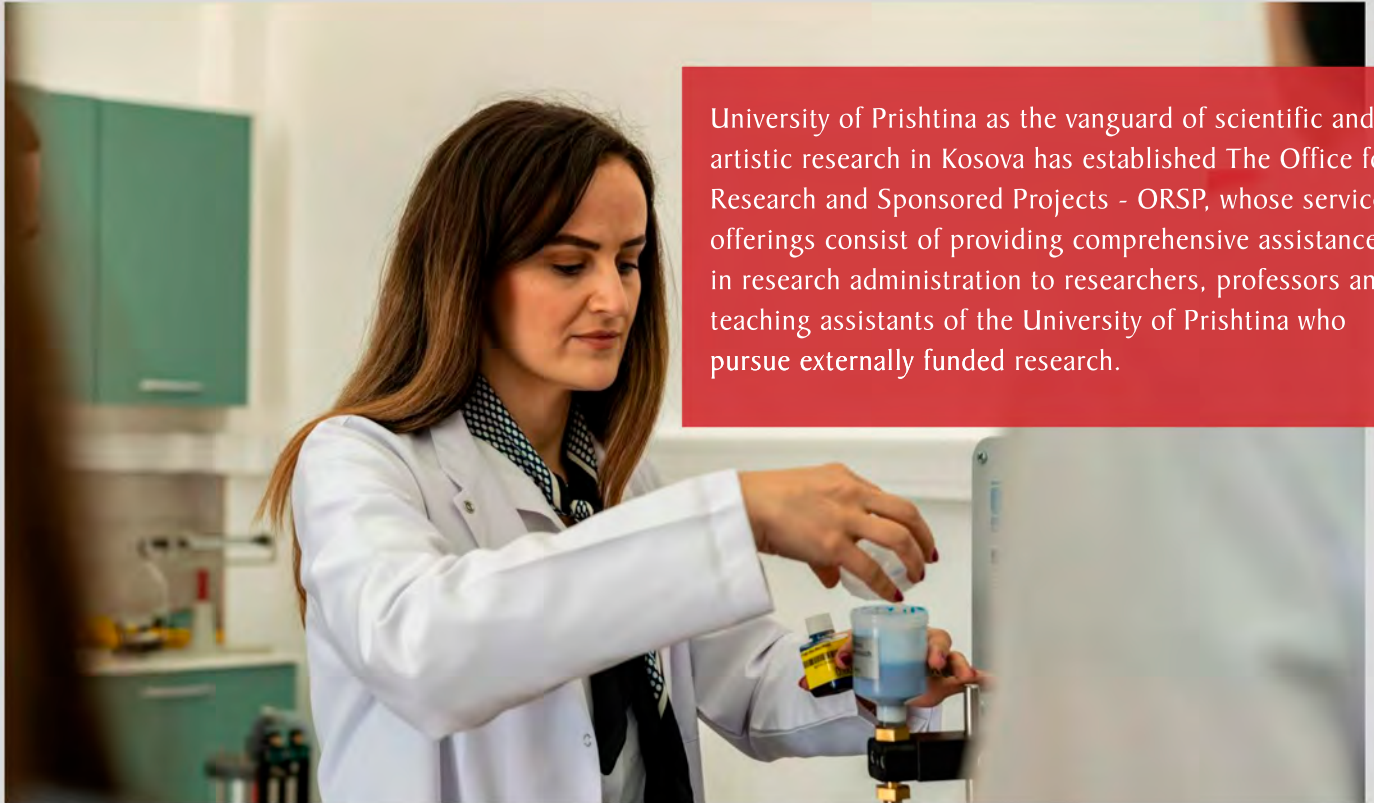
Working in close cooperation with academic units, the Centre promotes equality and inclusion by offering tailored support services, including technological assistance, to address diverse learning and participation requirements.

OFFICE FOR SPONSORED RESEARCH AND PROJECTS - OSRP



University of Prishtina as the vanguard of scientific and artistic research in Kosova has established The Office for Research and Sponsored Projects - ORSP, whose service offerings consist of providing comprehensive assistance in research administration to researchers, professors and teaching assistants of the University of Prishtina who pursue externally funded research.

The ORSP serves as a liaison between academic staff of the University of Prishtina and organizations, agencies and foundations with sponsorship/financing programs for research projects. The ORSP promotes opportunities for sponsored projects and research, provides assistance in drafting and developing projects, as well as in all administrative procedures before and after the development of the project.

The ORSP deals with the academic profile of the University of Prishtina and is engaged in improving the ranking of the institution in ranking lists with academic character.

The University of Prishtina has Elsevier subscription, which provides the academic staff and the students with access to scientific papers' platforms. The academic staff and the students have access to Scopus, ScienceDirect, Mendeley, as well as other services of the academic publisher, Elsevier.
