









Guidelines for Preparation and Submission of Abstracts

We are pleased to announce the call for abstracts for the First International Conference on Agriculture, Food Sciences, and Veterinary Medicine. We welcome submissions from researchers, academicians, practitioners, and students in these fields. Please adhere to the following guidelines for preparing and submitting your abstract:

- **1. Encouragement for Unpublished Results:** We strongly encourage the submission of abstracts describing unpublished results. This is an excellent opportunity to present your novel findings to a diverse audience.
- **2. Submission Method:** Abstracts (oral/poster presentation) should be submitted via email to [fsav.conference@uni-pr.edu]
- **3. Language and Formatting:** All abstracts must be written and presented in English using US English spelling. Accepted file formats for submission are .doc, .docx, or .pdf.
- **4. Abstract Length:** The main text of the abstract should not exceed 350 words.
- **5. Content Structure:** Your abstract should include the following sections:
 - Title: A concise title that clearly indicates the topic of the research.
 - Authors: Full names of all authors, with the presenting author underlined.
 - Affiliations: Affiliations of all authors.
 - Introduction: A brief introduction to the topic and objectives of the research.
 - Methods: A summary of the methods used in the research.
 - Results: Key findings of the research.
 - Conclusion: Implications of the findings and any future research directions.

- **6. Registration Requirement:** All presenting authors must register for the conference.
- **7. Review Process:** All submitted abstracts will undergo a peer-review process. Notification of acceptance will be sent via email.
- **8. Submission Deadline:** The deadline for abstract submission is [20.06.2024]. Late submissions will not be accepted.











Guidelines for Poster Preparation

Please adhere to the following guidelines to ensure a smooth and effective presentation:

1. Poster Size and Format: The maximum poster size is A1 size (59.4 x 84.1 cm) in portrait orientation. Posters should be readable from a distance of at least 1.5 meters.

2. Content Structure:

- Title: At the top of the poster, include the title of your research, the names of the authors, and their affiliations.
 - Introduction: Provide background information and the objectives of your research.
 - Methods: Summarize the methodology used in your research.
 - Results: Highlight the key findings with figures, tables, and charts.
 - Conclusion: Present the main conclusions and implications of your findings.
 - References: Include key references if necessary.
 - Acknowledgments: Recognize any funding sources or contributions.
- **3. Design and Layout:** Use a clear and simple layout with logical flow. Use bullet points and concise text to enhance readability. Use high-resolution images, graphs, and charts to visually represent data. Choose fonts that are easy to read; recommended font sizes are:

- Title: 85-100 pt

- Headings: 50-60 pt

- Body Text: 24-36 pt

- **4. Printing and Materials:** Presenters are responsible for printing their posters. The conference will not provide printing services. Use high-quality paper or material that can withstand handling and display.
- **5. Presentation:** Posters will be displayed in the designated poster area for the duration of the conference. Presenters are required to be available during the poster session to discuss their work and answer questions.
